# TRAVEL INFORMATION

The Great Fjord Swim takes place at: Killary Adventure Centre, Leenane, Connemara, Co. Galway H91 PY61.

### FLYING INTO DUBLIN

Upon landing in Dublin Airport, you have a few options:

- **Local Car Rental:** This would enable you to drive all the way to Connemara and view some sights along the way or over the weekend. The drive from Dublin Airport is around 3.5 hours.
- **Bus:** Take the bus to Galway and then use a Citylink bus to Letterfrack. From there you can get a taxi to Leenane. It is only 20 min by car/taxi.
- **Train:** Take the bus to Heuston Station and fetch a train to Westport. From there it is only a 20 min drive by car/taxi.

### FERRY INTO DUBLIN HARBOUR

Take the ferry into Dublin Harbour and drive approx. 3.5 hours all the way to Leenane. You will be on the motorway till Galway and pass through some nice towns on your way to the Killary Adventure Centre in Lennane.

### FLYING INTO KNOCK

Book your flight to Knock and choose your travel option:

- **Local Car Rental:** This will give you lots of flexibility to get to the Leenane plus take in a few sights over the weekend. The drive is around 1.5 hours from Knock Airport to Leenane. Or 50 min into Westport.
- **Bus:** Alternatively take the Bus Eireann Route 248 from Knock to Westport. You can then get a taxi from Westport to Killary Adventure Company in Leenane. This is a 30 minute drive/taxi ride.
- **Taxi:** Arrange for a taxi pick up from the airport to the location you are staying. Reach out to Tony Lowry a local taxi driver 00353 87 2348929 to get more details.

### FLYING INTO SHANNON

Flying into Shannon Airport Shannon Airport is a good 2.5 hours drive from Leenane. It's a long stretch but if you want to make a trip out of it and see some amazing sights along the way. This might be a good option for you. You could rent a car at the airport and make your way up along the Cliffs of Moher, Galway and Connemara.
